- Last date for submission of the full paper is on or before March 5, 2024 to the e-mail sjcemns2024@gmail.com
- Communication of acceptance of the paper is on March 10, 2024.
- If the paper is authored by more than one author, any one author has to present the paper. Certificate will be issued to only the participant who has attended and presented the paper.
- If the paper is co-authored, each author should register separately to get certificate.
- All papers will be subject to peer review by the expert committee.
- Selected papers will be published later with extra publication fees.
- APA (7th edition) guidelines to be followed in citation, documentation and referencing.
- The paper must be prepared in A4 size, typed in MS word format only, Times New Roman font with heading in font size 14 and text in font size 12 with 1.5 line spacing & justified.
- Word specification: Abstract 300 words, Full length papers 1500-2000 words.
