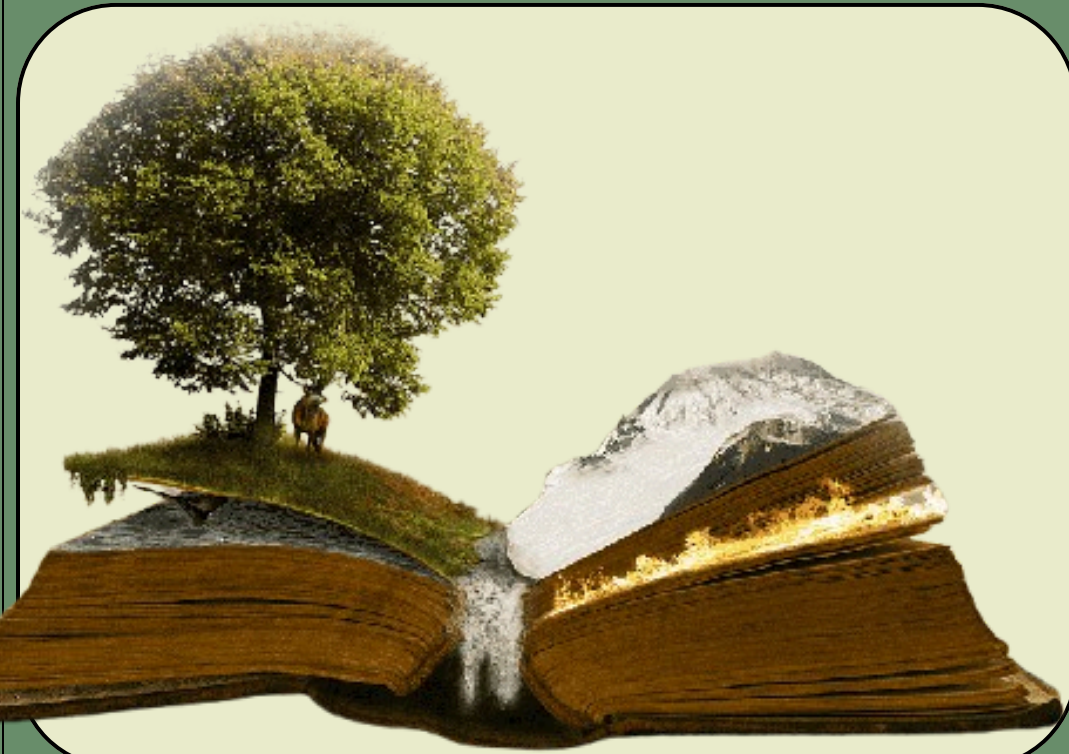

- The paper must be prepared in A4 size, typed in MS word format only, Times New Roman font with heading in font size 14 and text in font size 12 with 1.5 line spacing & justified.
- APA (7th edition) guidelines to be followed in citation, documentation and referencing. Click the link for guidelines <https://rb.gy/qzrel6>
- If the paper is authored by more than one author, any one author has to present the paper. Certificate will be issued to only the participant who has attended and presented the paper. Each author should register separately to get certificate.

- Seminar paper should be original, unpublished and adhere to seminar theme.
- All papers will be subject to peer review by the expert committee.
