Facilities in the College: Infrastructure, Learning Resources and Services

Computer / Educational Technology Laboratory: The college computer laboratory has given the faculty and the students, access to the world of information, and hands-on experience helps to usher in Educational Technology along with the innumerable application of Multimedia Education. The current B.Ed., Degree Programme has Computer Education as an integral part and facilities are available to meet with requirements of this input. Use of Interactive digital Smart boards, LCD projectors, Laptop, Digital Camera and Handy-Cam lend relevant support in all the lecture halls.

Science Laboratories: Well-equipped physics, chemistry and biology laboratories prepare our teacher trainees to develop and impart scientific skills relevant to the need of the hour.

Psychology Laboratory: Well-equipped psychology lab with tests and tools to test the psychological concepts like, intelligence, aptitude, attitude, perceptions, etc.

Guidance & Counseling Centre:

The students can freely approach this center for Guidance or Counseling regarding various aspects of their life.

Grievance Redressal Cell:

Any complaint/grievance regarding the student, institution, etc., can be made to this cell directly or can be put into the grievance box kept at an easily accessible place. The complaints will be dealt with immediate and necessary measures at the earliest by the committee handling this cell.

Women's Cell

Women's Cell has been constituted as a platform to address issues related to women like harassment, eve teasing, etc., creating awareness about women rights and empower women students by organizing awareness programmes.

Placement Cell

The placement cell functioning in the college assists students in finding out career opportunities both inside and outside Karnataka. A good number of students made use of this opportunity and are serving as efficient and committed teachers in almost all parts of the country and thereby contributing to national development.

Prayer Hall

Curricular and Extracurricular Activities

Practice Teaching Schools:-

Various reputed secondary schools in and around the city of Mysore are on our list of practicing schools where students are interned for 50 working days of teaching. St.Joseph's High School on the campus serves as a demonstration school for our educational needs along with St Philomena's High School, St Matthias High School, Good Shepherd Convent High School, Christ the King of High School, Avila High School, St Anthony's High School, Nirmala High School, Brindavan High School, Vivekananda High School, St. Anne's High School and St. Mary's High School, to name a few, who contribute their maximum with the internship Programme. A wide range of activities are organized in the College throughout the academic year to train our student teachers in organizational skills and to give them better exposure.

Tutorials, Projects and Assignments are conducted for all the students under the guidance of faculty members as a part of curriculum.

Socially Useful Productive Work:- (SUPW) A Programme of socially useful productive work exposes our teachers to the world of work inculcating dignity of labour in them.

College Newsletter: - our Annual College Newsletter- 'Milestones' capture our literary talent and is an index of the students' caliber.

The library collection includes 16,713 books, both for borrowing and reference. Free internet access is allowed to students and faculty of the college. Library Rules
