Faculty members attended number of Seminars, conferences and workshops at national and one of the Faculty members Dr. Maria Ugin Joseph presented a paper at international level. Mr Prasanth Joshi and Mrs. Vasudha got permanent registration for PhD and pursuing their research.

Faculty members participated in Mysore University level orientation programme to the new 2 year B.Ed course. Three faculty members were resource persons in preparation of 5 E model lesson plans. Academic activities started with the orientation programme. Orientation programme gave a bird's eye view of the entire B.Ed programme. The first activity which was conducted for developing confidence and communicative competency was communication skill workshop. Communication skills workshop was organized from 3rd to 4th April 2017.
