

From 18th November 2020 to 20th November 2020

Under IQAC of the college, the 1<sup>st</sup> year students of B.Ed. organized the "TECH SAVVY" Programme. It was peer group tutoring on video recording and video editing.

With the support of the Principal, Priya Mathew and staff members of St. Joseph's college of education Mysuru, students got an opportunity to learn about this through Online.

- > Taught how to save the video.


And that's the last day of our TECH SAVVY programme and we recap all the 3 days lessons and clarify all their doubts.






The webinar started at 10:30 am with a short prayer. The inaugural address was delivered by Mr.Seby Maveli, CEO if Training and Development, MDES.




### A Report on One Day National Webinar

### AN EDUCATIONAL LEAP WITH ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE


Organised by IQAC, St. Joseph's College of Education On Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021




School Teachers of MDES 16<sup>th</sup> July to 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021

Sr. Bincy Manuel of II B. Ed got the privilege to anchor the entire session.



The welcome address and introduce the resource person was done by Mrs. Nageshwari P.N, Coordinator, Assistant Professor, SJCE.


