
Principles of Human Development ವಿಕಾಸದ ತತ್ವಗಳು

- 1. Principle of continuity
 - Linked with the previous
- 2. Principle of Sequential development
 - Specific pattern/design
- 3. Principle of cephalo-caudal Tendency
 - Head to heel
- 4. Principle of proximo-distal trend
 - Near to distant

Head to tail

Cephalocaudal direction

 The process of cephalocaudal direction from head down to tail.
 This means that improvement in structure and function come first in the head region, then in the trunk, and last in the leg region.




proximodistal

Proximodistal direction

- Growth proceeds from the center, or midline, of the body to the periphery, or in a proximodistal direction.
- This proximodistal development is bilateral and symmetric, for the most part, on both side of the body; however, this is not consistently true.



- Slower in the development of different qualities

Based on charles sprearman's general theory of intelligence – Horizontal correlation

- Physical inter relation (eating food proximo distal) and mental inter relation.
- Robert sternberg's triarchic theory of intelligence
 - 1. Analytic /ವಿಶ್ಲೇಶಣಾತ್ಮಕ ಬುದ್ದಿಶಕ್ತಿ = problem solving
 - 2. Creative/ಸೃಜನಾತ್ಮಕ ಬುದ್ದಿಶಕ್ತಿ = new situation + past skills
 - 3. Practical / ಪ್ರಾಯೋಗಿಕ ಬುದ್ದಿಶಕ್ತಿ = ability to adapt





Integration




This refers to the organization or putting together

- Inborn traits and envt traits



- 2. Narrating a story




